During the repair of Calverley Old Hall in 2023, we ran a series of workshops to teach people the art of stone carving. During the workshop, each person carved a stone inspired by Calverley Old Hall.

Head outside to explore, and look for the carved stones which are hidden all around the garden, including the Community Garden.

Remember to take an adult!

There are 20 stones to find, can you find them all?



The Calverley family coat of arms features a horned owl. Can you find our three Calverley owls?



A 'grotesque' figure, sometimes seen on churches, and popular in medieval times. Can you find him?



This stone is inspired by the fireplace in the Community Space, can you find it in the garden?



We found lots of hidden objects at Calverley Old Hall. Can you find the child's shoe?



Some of the stones are inspired by the people who used to live here. Two of the stones feature people, one shows the Calverley family. Can you find them both?



Can you find the blocked medieval window in the wall of the Great Hall?







These designs are all inspired by the old cottages at Calverley Old Hall, using bits of wallpaper and old tiles. Can you find these carved flowers?





Sadly, in the 1970s, part of Calverley Old Hall caught fire. Can you find these two designs inspired by the flames?

These designs were inspired by patterns on the Tudor wall paintings. Can you find the mythical creatures and the rose?









Some of the stones include features in the building, like the chapel screen and patterns in the intricate windows. How many can you recognise?
